

Regular Meeting
Louisa County Conservation Board
March 12, 2008

The Louisa County Conservation Board met in regular session on Wednesday, March 12, 2008 at 5:30 p.m. at the Louisa County Conservation Board office. Members present were: Doug Brown, Dave Schweitzer, Brad Moss and Jay Schweitzer. Others present were: Julie Ohde, Jeff Snyder and Dean Mumme.

D. Schweitzer moved to approve the agenda; Moss seconded; motion passed.

Angie Sanders, Louisa Development Group executive director, gave a presentation on recreational trends.

D. Schweitzer moved to approve the consent agenda; Brown seconded; motion passed.

Snyder gave his recommendation for equipment purchases, taking in to account differences in product specs. D. Schweitzer moved to accept bids from Morning Sun Implement (mower and utility vehicle) and Elder Implement (tractor and trailer); Brown seconded; motion passed.

D. Schweitzer moved to purchase a computer from VP Enterprise; Brown seconded; motion passed.

D. Schweitzer moved to enter into an agreement with the Louisa County Historical Society to provide staff at the museum in Wapello; Brown seconded; motion passed.

The board was not interested in allowing fall tillage on conservation board rental property and no motion was put forward.

Ohde updated the board on efforts to find a location for an Iowa River boat ramp in the Gladwin area.

The board discussed the need for an appraisal of property adjacent to Chinkapin Bluffs for possible purchase. Since the appraisal would only be valid for a few months, no action was taken at this time.

No action was taken regarding the contract with Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation for the Crumley property.

D. Schweitzer moved to set 2008 camping fees at \$12 for electric camp sites at Snively Access and \$10 for all other sites and campgrounds; Moss seconded; motion passed.

The next regular meeting was set for Wednesday, April 9 at 5:30 p.m.

The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
