

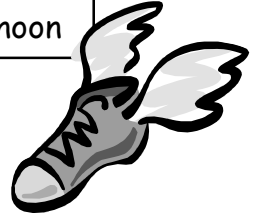
2008 Morning Sun Summer Rec

- July 9 & 16 **Amazing Race**: Small teams will participate in The Amazing Race: Morning Sun Edition. Kids will complete a list of fun, challenging tasks as quickly as possible at the park (Tasks are kept secret until race time).
- July 10 & 17 **Summer Survival**: More fun stuff. Individual challenge tasks. Parachute Games (mushroom, cat and mouse, sharks), “Obstacle course” (timed) and “Water Race”.
