The Louisa County Conservation Board met in special session on Wednesday, December 21, 5:30 p.m. at the Louisa County Conservation office. Members present were: Sherry Humphreys, Brad Moss, Jay Schweitzer, Roger Edwards and Stan Staats. Others present: Jeff Snyder.

Ohde presented the two versions of the proposed FY 2013 budget for consideration. One includes a request for creating a natural resource manager position with about half of the cost coming from property taxes. An informational sheet describes the position and the benefits to the public. Moss moved to approve the proposed FY2013 budget with the natural resource manager position; Schweitzer seconded; motion passed with three ayes, one nay and one abstention.
